- Please return the completed form to the County Co-ordinator together with a cheque for £55 made payable to **Bowls Kent Coaching Association**, or by bank transfer to **Sort Code: 30-92-53, Account No.: 00243557**, **please do not send cash** – the cost includes a copy of the Laws of the Sport, Manual for Level 1 and 2 Foundation, but if you do not wish to proceed to Level 2, you will then receive a Level 1 cloth badge and upon completion of Foundation Level 1, you will be required to pay a £6.00 fee for registration, this will include insurance with the ECBS. Just remember, as a Level 1 you can only coach a new bowler NOT someone who has a problem with their bowling.
- For those not continuing to Level 2 you will require a Level 1 certificate at an additional fee of £5.00. The fee covers your registration. Your insurance will cover you up to 30th September each year.
- If you wish to proceed to Level 2 Club Coach and after your assessment £5.00 is required. This will be for your certificate (you will also receive a Level 2 cloth badge and a Student Pack that will help you in your coaching career).
- Thereafter you must renew your EBCS registration annually at a cost of £6 (you may be asked to submit a copy of your logbook to the County Co-ordinator in order to ensure your continued licence as an accredited coach). **You will be required to obtain a D.B.C.S. once you have completed your Level 1 assessment.** This can be organised through Carol Watt-Sullivan (email: carolwattsullivan@viginmedia.com).
